

Hampshire Membership Terms and Conditions

By taking out membership you are agreeing to abide by the ticket terms and conditions and conditions of entry as outlined below.

As a member you will receive news & special offers from Hampshire Cricket and Utilita Bowl. You can unsubscribe from these communications at any time. For further information, please read our privacy policy which is available at www.utilitabowl.com/privacy

The membership contract runs from the date of purchase and terminates at the end of each season.

Those purchasing a Junior (U17), Premium 17-21 or Premium 22-29 membership must be the valid age on 1st April of the upcoming season. Age checks may be requested to confirm validity.

Duplicate Membership cards can be applied for in writing to The Ticket and Membership Office specifying the circumstances of the loss. The Club reserves the right to decline the request and a £5.00 duplicate fee will be charged.

You will be asked to scan your Membership card at the turnstiles to enter the ground during Hampshire home matches afforded to your category of Membership. Please note that Membership cards are non-transferable (this does not apply to Executive Club Memberships) and will be confiscated if presented by anyone other than the registered holder to gain admission.

We ask that your Membership card is always visible to stewards when you attend Hampshire matches at Utilita Bowl.

Auto-Renew & Direct Debit payments

At the end of each season any member who has paid for membership via Auto-Renew or Direct Debit will automatically be renewed.

Direct Debits for the next season can be cancelled at any point up until 1st December that year, after this date your payment will be automatically taken in the second week of January.

Members buying international tickets but then cancelling their Auto-Renew/Direct Debit renewal will have their international tickets cancelled and refunded in line with the venue's ticket refund policy.

International Matches

During international matches held at Utilita Bowl Hampshire Members can purchase a valid Members Area seat ticket in Block W, X, A or B to gain entry to the ground. Membership cards will not be valid to access the ground during international matches.

Car Parking

Car Park Season passes that cover all Hampshire home matches are available from the Membership & Ticket Office at Utilita Bowl or via the website <https://tickets.utilitabowl.com/content>

Parking passes are not valid for International Fixtures, The Hundred or any Concerts held at Utilita Bowl.

Car Park passes must be displayed at all times by hanging on the rear-view mirror, coloured side facing the windscreen, at all times when attending cricket matches at Utilita Bowl. Please take care of your Car Park pass as duplicate passes will only be issued in exceptional circumstances and charges will apply.

We reserve the right to change the specific location of the season ticket holders' car park.

All on-site parking is subject to availability. Hampshire Cricket reserves the right to close any part of the ground if required for reason of health and safety, operational necessity or any other purpose.

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
